



The Facts:

- Tractor overturns are the leading cause of farm-related deaths.
- Rollover protection structures are 99% effective in preventing these deaths.

The Program:

- The National Farm Medicine Center received generous donations from the Auction of Champions, an annual fundraiser for farm health and safety in Marshfield WI, to develop a ROPS Rebate Program.
- The ROPS Rebate Program will rebate 70% of the cost of purchasing and installing the ROPS and seatbelt (up to \$865 maximum).

How It Works:

- Farmers call the ROPS Hotline (1-877-ROPS-R4U or 1-877-767-7748) or visit www.ropsr4u.com for registration.
 1. Hotline staff researches the ROPS options for the tractor make and model, provides estimated costs and sources for purchasing ROPS. The information is sent to farmers by mail.
- Farmers choose the ROPS options they like best.
- Farmers call the ROPS Hotline to obtain pre-approval for the ROPS option they selected (**PRE-APPROVAL IS REQUIRED TO ENSURE REBATE FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE**).
- Farmers order their ROPS through their local dealer or the ROPS manufacturer.
- Farmers call the ROPS Hotline to confirm the order and reserve their rebate money (cost may be different than the estimate).
- Farmers send copies of receipts (proof of purchase and installation of ROPS and seatbelt) to Hotline staff.
 1. The National Farm Medicine Center mails a rebate check within 30 days of receiving receipts.
