What costs are covered by the rebate?

◉ Rebate

- 70% of the retrofit costs to maximum \$865

◉ Covered Costs

- Rollover protection structure (ROPS) (rigid, folding, with canopy)
- Seatbelt
- Shipping
- Trailering
- Installation



Who is eligible for the rebate program?

- ◎ Wisconsin residents who are full-time or part-time farmers



How does the rebate program work?

- Call the ROPS Rebate Hotline to register (1-877-ROPS-R4U or 1-877-767-7748)
- You will receive information on ROPS options for your tractor(s), costs, and sources
- When you are ready to make your purchase, call the Hotline to set aside the rebate money for you



How does the rebate program work?

- ① Contact your local dealer to order and install the ROPS and seatbelt
- ② Once the ROPS and seatbelt are installed, send in a copy of all receipts
- ③ A rebate check of 70% up to a maximum of \$865 will be sent within 30 days (average is 10 business days)
